Site updates

- In the next couple of months, we'll be adding an additional administrative building in town to provide more space for our technicians.
- Several new hires from Paintearth County have joined our team, including a new Operations Coordinator from right here in Halkirk.
- Copper theft continues to be a challenge and I would like to extend a heartfelt thank you to the Coronation RCMP and all the Landowners who have aided in curtailing these activities.
- There have been several main component changes this year including removal of the blades, hub, gearbox and mainshaft at T50 to facilitate the replacement of the mainshaft.

H2 update

At the end of August, overall construction of our Halkirk 2 Wind project, located 12 km NE of Halkirk was 80% complete and is anticipated to be operational in late 2024. The 126 MW facility consists of 28 Vestas V150-4.5™ wind turbines, the first of which was fully assembled on July 21, 2024 (pictured at right).
